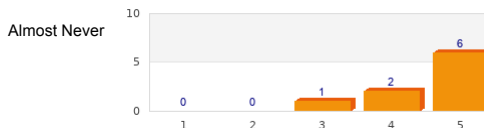

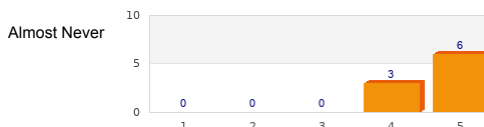
1.1) The instructor presented the course material clearly. Almost Always **n=9**

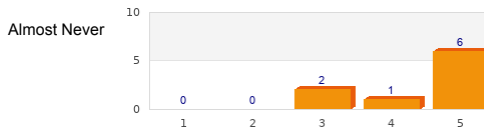
1.4) Tests and assignments were related to material covered in class. Almost Always **n=9**

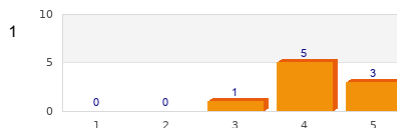

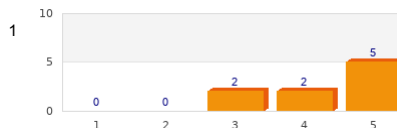

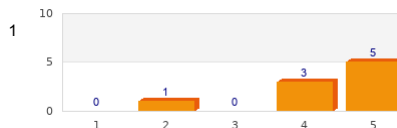
2.1) How much do you feel you learned in this course?

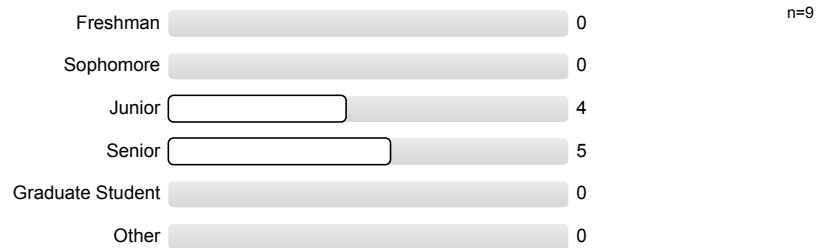

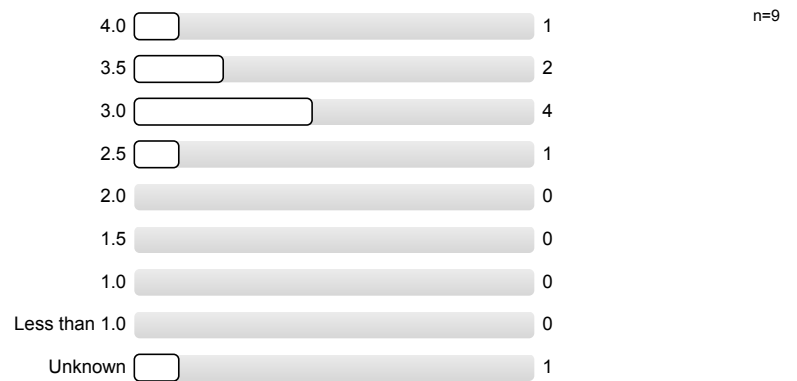

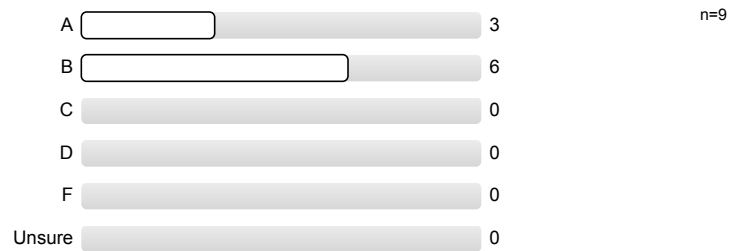
