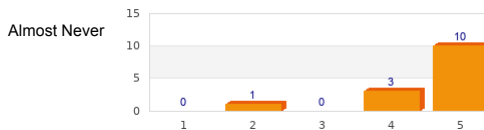

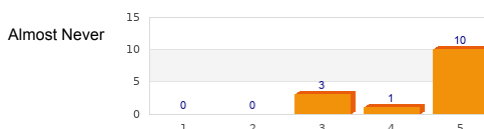
1.1) The instructor presented the course material clearly. Almost Always **n=14**
av.=4.6



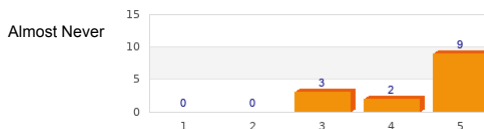
1.2) The instructor stimulated interest in this subject. Almost Always **n=14**

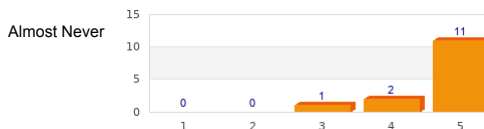
1.3) The instructor cleared up points of confusion. Almost Always **n=14**

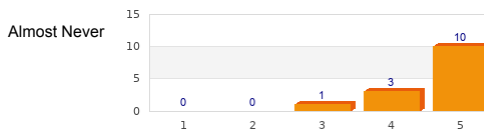
1.4) Tests and assignments were related to material covered in class. Almost Always **n=14**

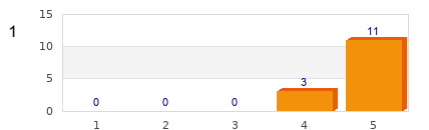

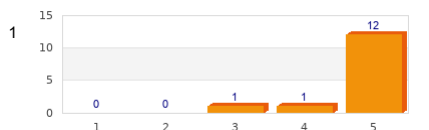

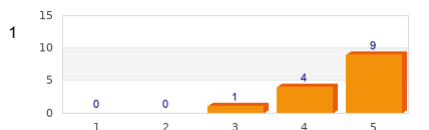
