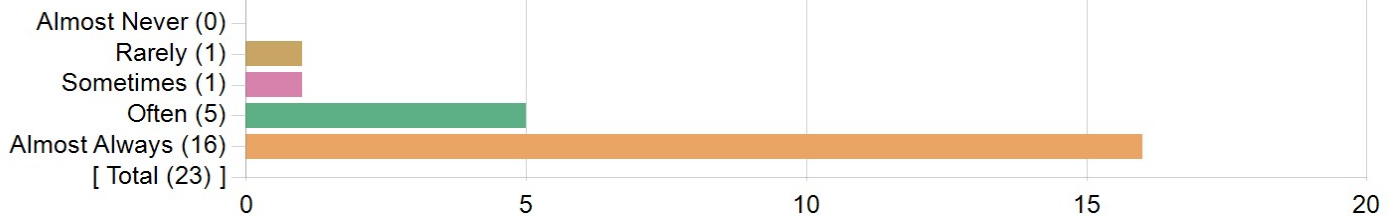

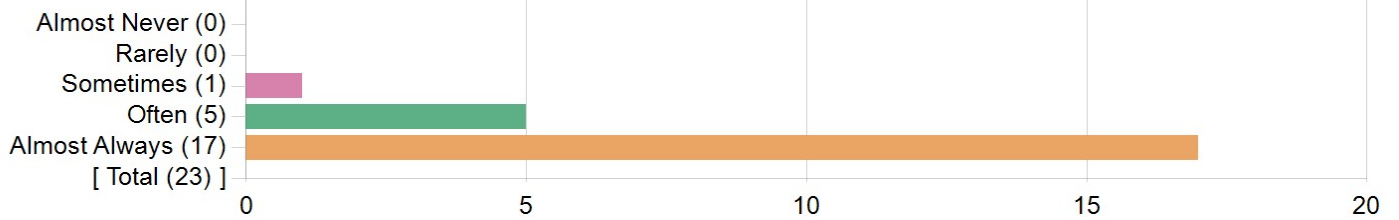

1. The instructor presented the course material clearly.



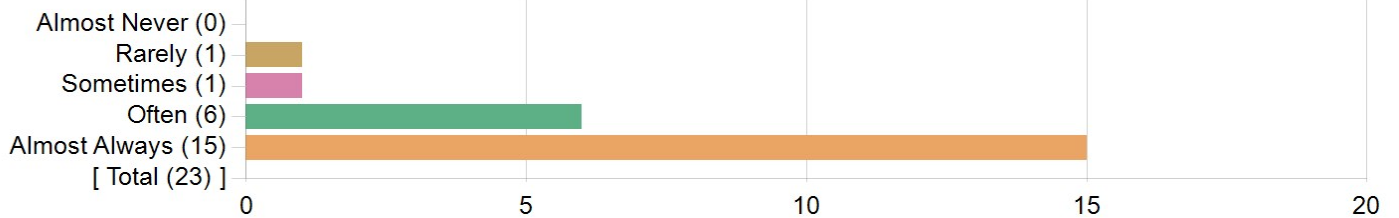

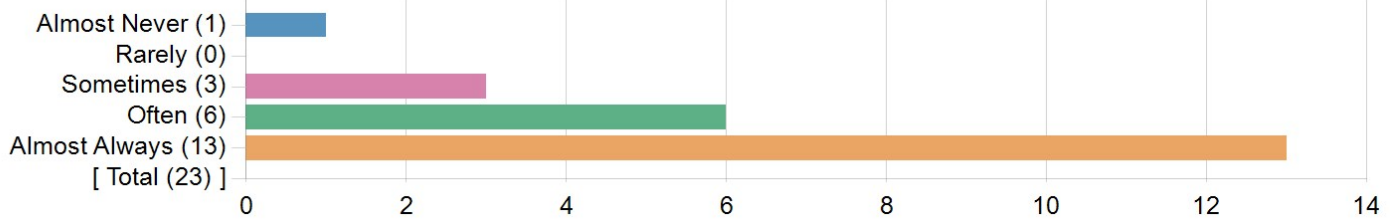

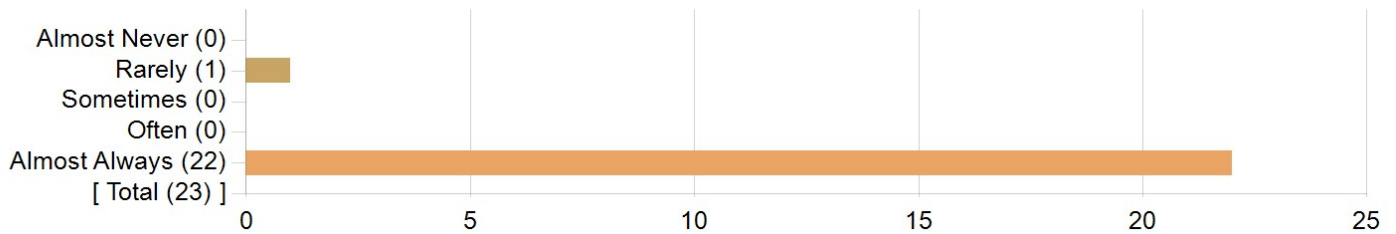

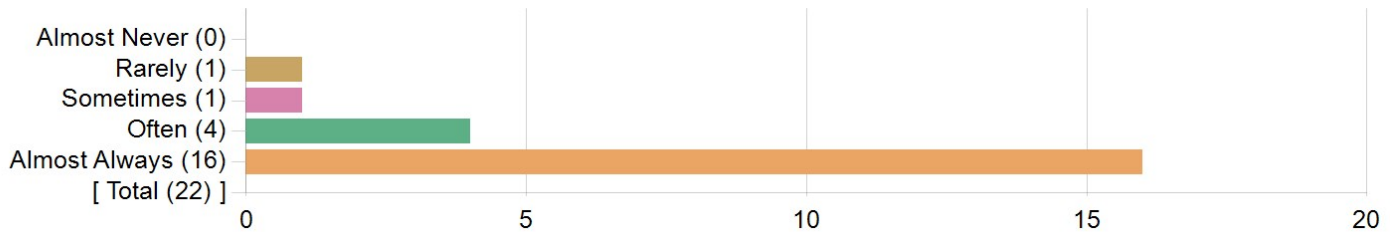

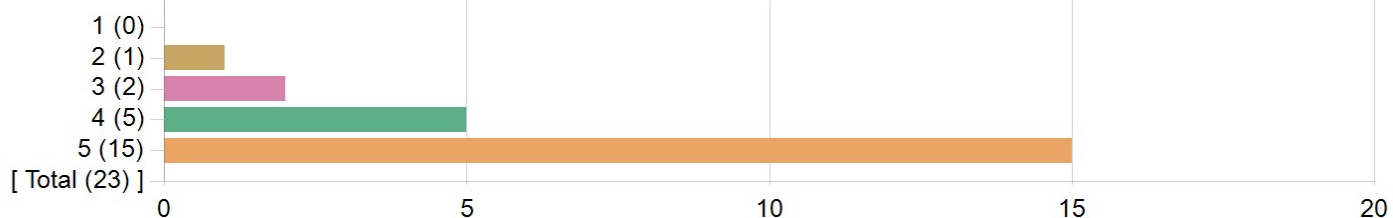

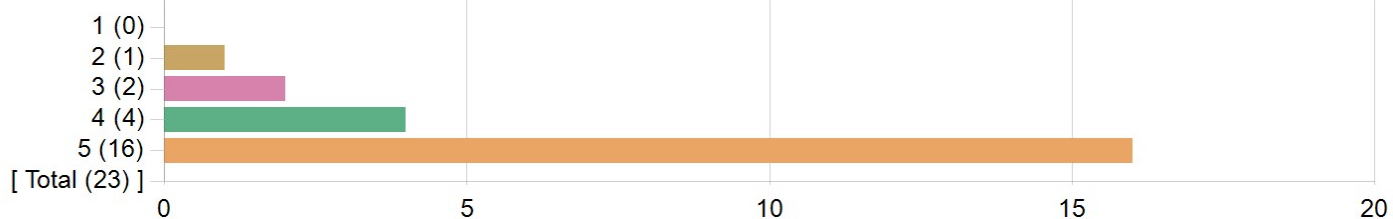

1. How much do you feel you learned in this course? (1=Nothing, 5=A lot)



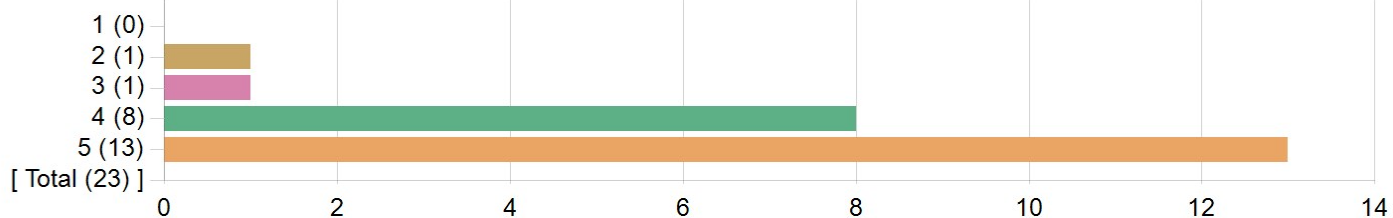

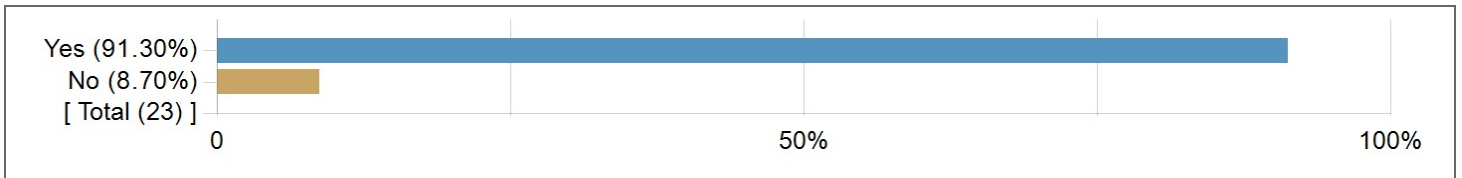

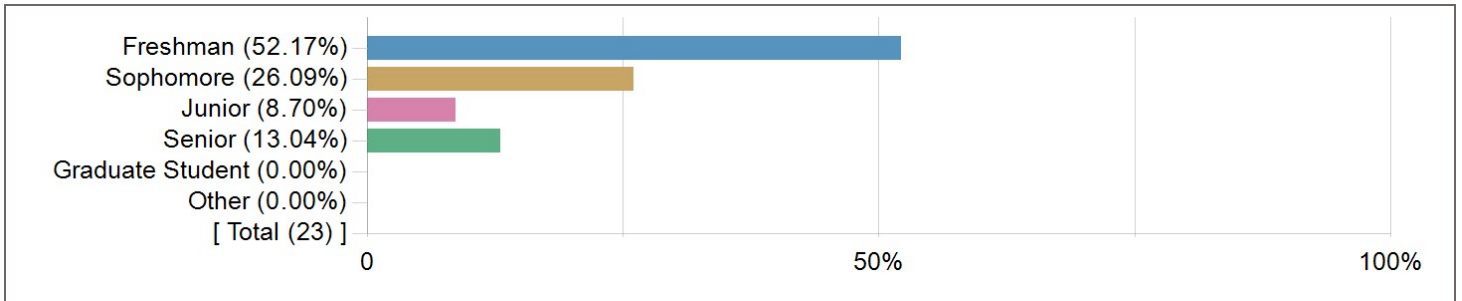

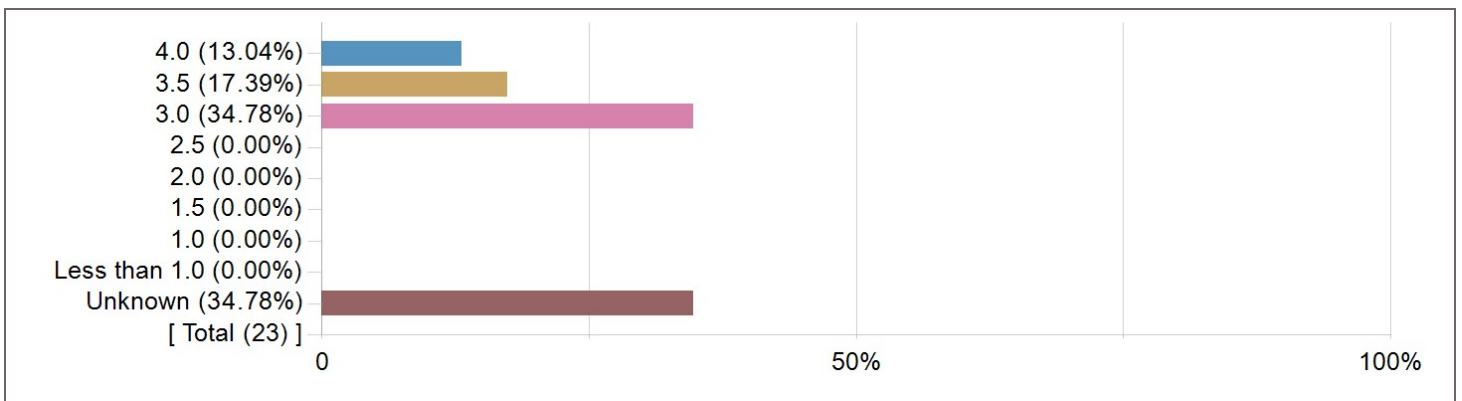

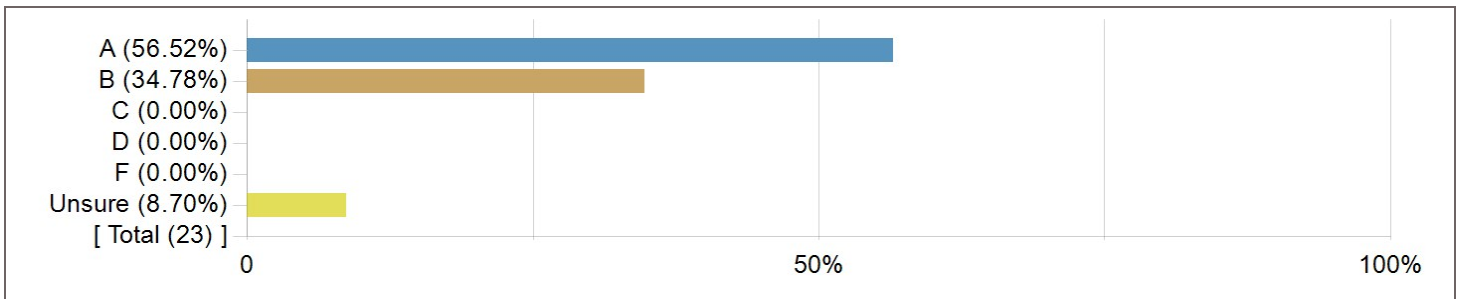
What is your class standing?
