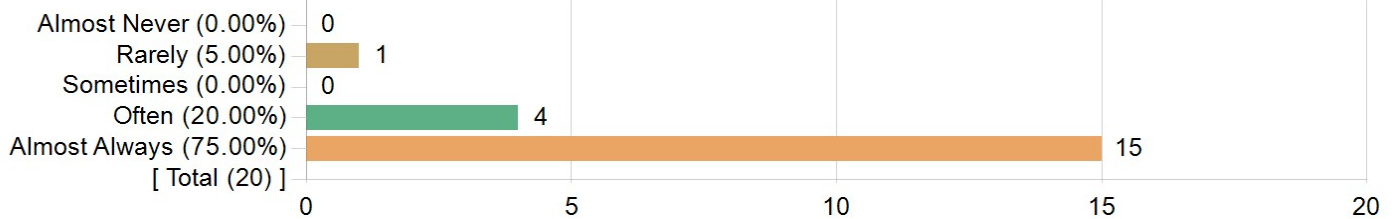

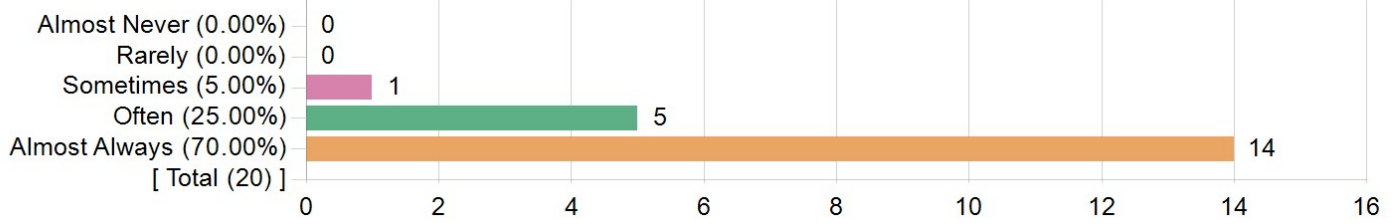

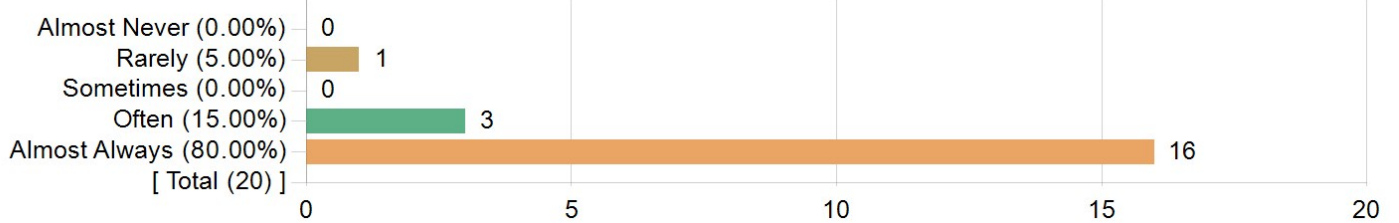

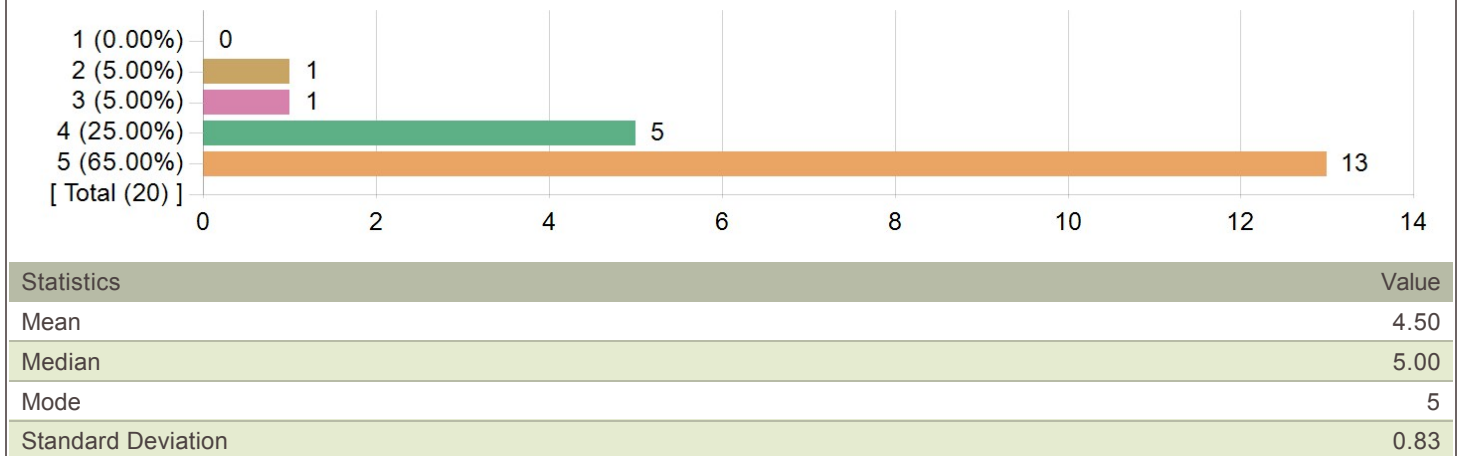

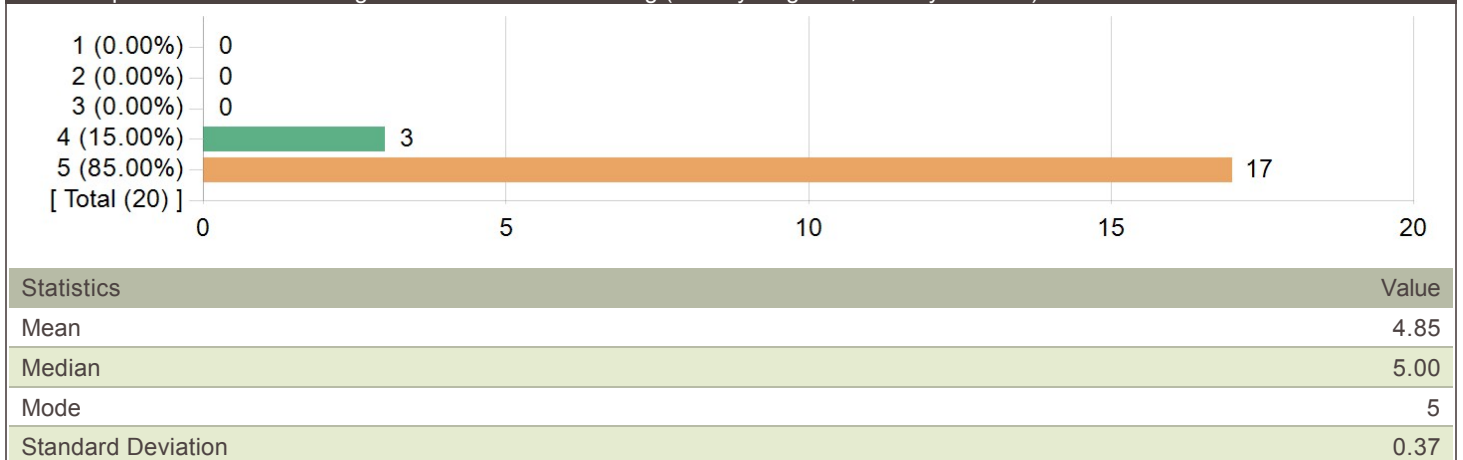

## Overall Impression of the Course

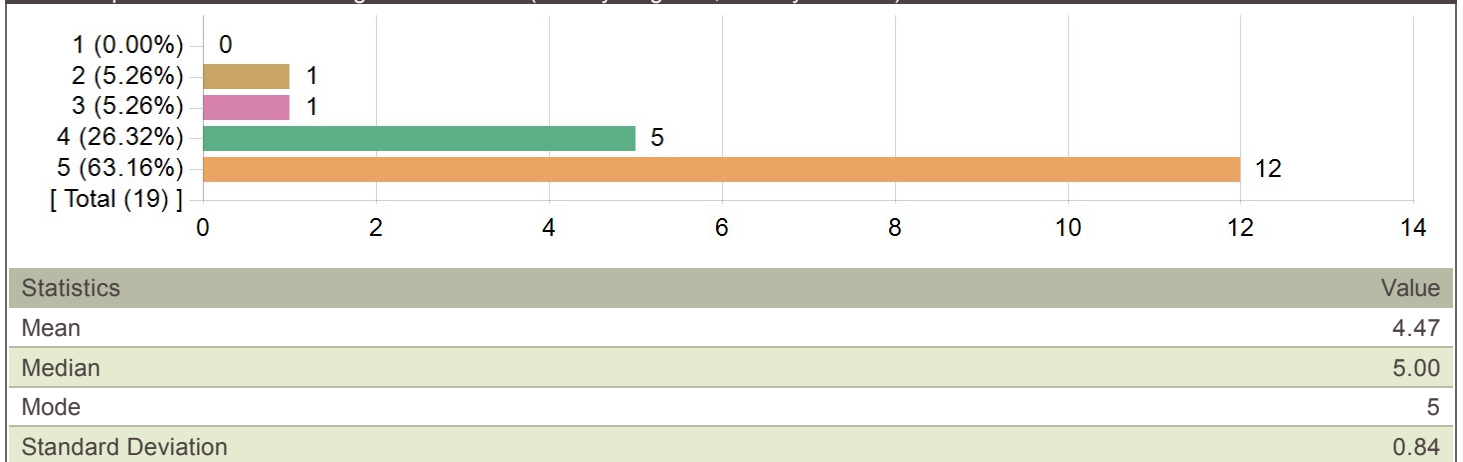
1. How much do you feel you learned in this course? (1=Nothing, 5=A lot)



2. Please provide an overall rating of this instructor's teaching. (1=Very Negative, 5=Very Positive)

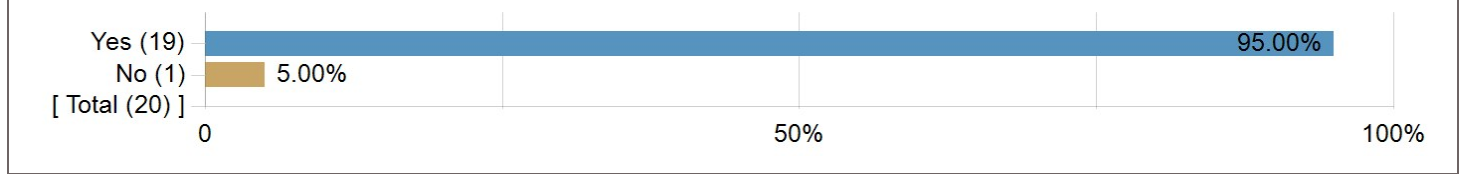

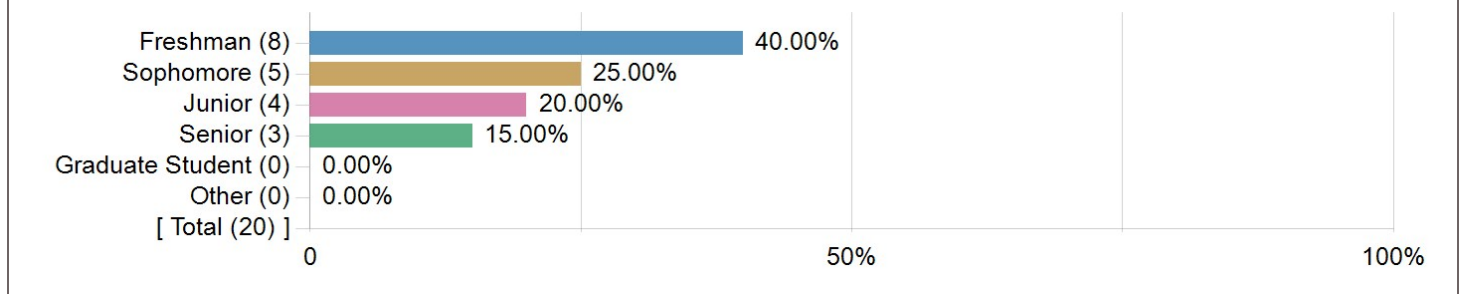

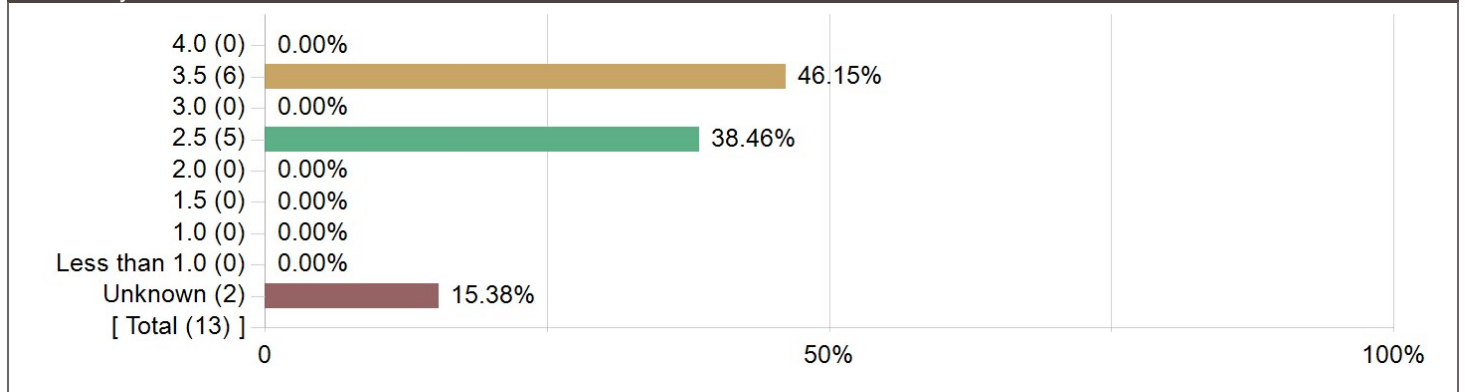

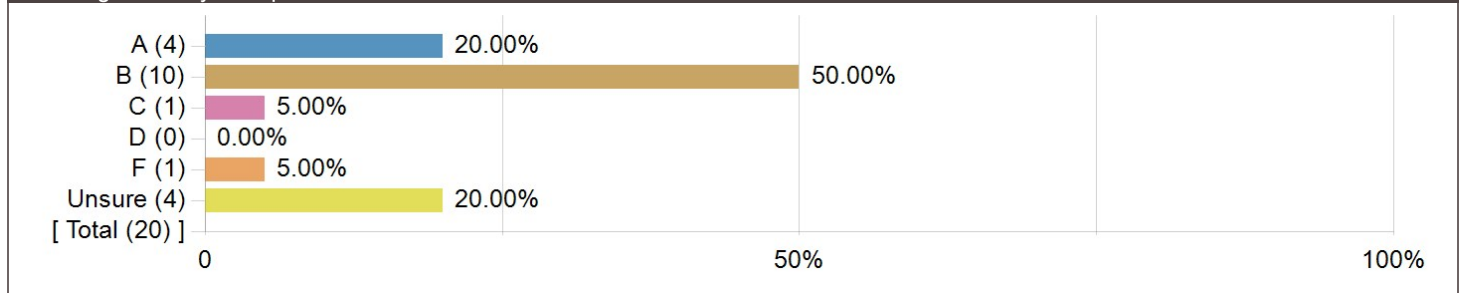
